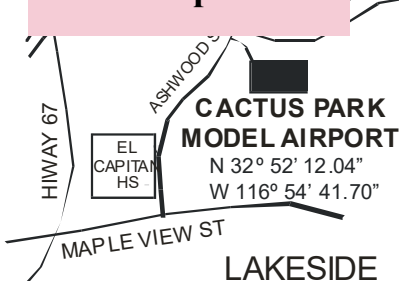
CORONA VIRUS and FWW / Cactus Park
