

Meeting Minutes 5 July 2025

<u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM at the field. Club officers present were the President, Vice President, Treasurer, and the Secretary. A total of 15 club members were present. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of minutes: Steve Shepersky moved the minutes of the June 7th, 2025 meeting be approved as submitted. Seconded by Vernon Gilmore. The motion was approved.

Treasurer's Report:

Keith Miller moved the treasurer's report be approved as submitted. Seconded by Vernon Gilmore. The motion was approved.

General Notes:

- The field will be closed from July 8th to July 23rd while the county takes down the fence and works on the West bank & hill. After discussion it was agreed they should take the entire fence down. The field will be open to flying on the weekends and during the week after 4:30 PM.
- Art will bring his skip loader next Saturday to move the safe.
- The plan is to clean the shed at the same time which includes getting rid of all the radios.
- A Big Thank You to Jeff Coskey for organizing the Dick Halbert estate sale. The

biggest success was the next day at Discount Hobby Warehouse. Total revenue to the club is \$3,635.00.

Safety Officer Report:

- There was a car accident on Ashwood at the field entrance last week. Reminder to use extreme caution when driving out onto Ashwood. Ron will request that the County cut the tree back to allow better visibility to the East. Ron will also request the County to improve the driveway.
- If you get cut, first apply direct pressure to control the bleeding. Evaluate the need to go to the ER. Apply the sock from the first aid kit as needed for bleeding prior to heading to the ER.

Rule review:

• The only place you can charge batteries is at charging tables. Do not charge on a metal table.

New Business:

 The tree stump in the picnic area needs to be removed. Jeff's neighbor has a tree stump grinder.

- Keith Miller moved that the club allocate \$250 to remove the stump. Lyle Black seconded. The motion was approved.
- Items are missing from the first aid kit (gloves & scissors). Let Ron know if you use something so he can replenish the kit.
- No news on the neighbor. No negative comments.
- The bins for used, old, damaged LiPo batteries have become a repository for other kinds of batteries and trash. Reminder that only LiPo model batteries are to be placed in the battery bins for disposal. Please do not put trash of any kind in them. Ron will continue to collect the LiPo batteries as they accumulate and soak them in a salt water bath for about a month and dispose as a courtesy to club members. Alternatively, it was mentioned that Discount Hobby will take your used LiPo batteries and dispose in the same manner.

Greetings everyone!

July was a productive month:

1) Jake is gone effective 1 August! The modified flight rules will be eliminated and will return to the original flight pattern. [Editor's note: An official revision to the rules is proposed in the Editor's Corner below.]

- 2) The plane-eating fence was removed.
- 3) We replaced the antiquated shed door with a new roll-up door.
- 4) The large useless safe was removed and hauled away thank you Art Flores!
- 5) The tall weeds were cut down to ground level.

I will provide masks and gloves for all participants. The more volunteers we have the quicker we can complete this task. Please call me if you plan to volunteer.

A special thank you to everyone for working around the County schedule while they were on site. The appearance of the park has improved considerably. We will be back to normal hours soon.

The next meeting is on Saturday, 2 August at 0900. On the same date a wedding is scheduled at the polo field. Our field will be closed at 1300 (1:00pm).

This is what Dean Nickol's 3-meter Fox glider looks like taking off from his custom-designed dolly. Very nicely done!




And this is what Dean's Fox looks like flying and landing as soon as he realized he'd forgotten to install the wing spar!
