

#### Field Closures Following Rain

For the time being, the County has instructed the Club to close the field during a rain event (of any measurable amount) to extend for five days after the conclusion of rain. The Board will email notifications of closures, and the gate lock will be temporarily disabled for member access. Please be patient while Ron continues to meet with the County. He's struggling to get them to understand that sink holes are formed *underground*, and not by surface water effects. The County also lost track of where they placed the 'hot zone cap' fifteen years ago (between the runway and the chain link fence).

<u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM at the field. Club officers present were the President, Vice President, Treasurer, and the Secretary. A total of 15 club members were present. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

- The main gate must remain closed at all times when club members are present and only locked when the last person leaves for the day. The North Gate needs to stay locked at all times and it does!
- Keith Miller reminded the group that the runway has always been a paved section of the county's property.
- The 5 day "no fly" rule following rain is still in effect.

We should be able to fly the day after Thanksgiving. The County is adamant about not flying for five days after it rains. Even if it sprinkles the County does not want anyone entering the field **five days after it rains.** 

I recently purchased a rain gauge for the field but regardless of the amount collected the County is holding firm with the five-day restriction. There was major reconstruction in Bonsall due to rain damage, so they have issued a blanket order for all burn sites and landfills. Our field is located over a landfill, so they are concerned about the possibility of sink holes due to subterranean water. This is a costly repair, so they are trying to avoid any additional expense. I will open the field the night before we can fly.

The Veterans Fly In was a huge success. I want to thank Brian and Phyllis for cooking and rebuilding the BBQ. [Editor's note: John Loerke's wife Sandy provided the baked beans, and Ron brought his signature potato salad.] I am happy to report that we collected a substantial amount of money for Toy for Tots. 




Kevin Roche,
